REGULATORY INFORMATION

Self-adhesive tapes must be labelled only when they can be classified as "packaging" pursuant to Article 218(1)(a) of Italian Legislative Decree 152/2006, i.e. a product made of materials of any nature used to contain certain goods, from raw materials to finished products, to protect them, enable their handling and delivery from the producer to the consumer or user, ensure their presentation, as well as disposable articles used for the same purpose.

Tapes are considered packaging when they are sold to industrial/professional users to perform this function (i.e. as a packaging component).

Tapes are not considered packaging when they are distributed and sold to the final consumer.

Packaging tapes are designed not to be separated from the packaging to which they are applied, but to ensure permanent closure and allow the packaging to be opened easily without compromising its functionality.

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Environmental labelling for adhesive tapes - continued

In fact, they do not need to be removed either partially or completely in order to open the box. Opening is normally carried out by cutting with a common cutter, leaving the tape adhered to the packaging.

Moreover, removal of self-adhesive tape from the packaging is generally not easy to perform manually and, where possible, results in significant removal of the material from which the packaging itself is made (mainly cardboard boxes). Self-adhesive packaging tapes can be separated from the packaging only during recovery/recycling operations and do not constitute an obstacle to the recyclability of cardboard boxes.

Consequently, for technical reasons and due to the intended purpose and functionality for which it is designed - which are contrary to removability - in most cases packaging adhesive tape cannot be considered a manually separable packaging component.

Tapes that have not been designed and manufactured to perform a packaging function are excluded from the labelling requirement (e.g. masking tapes and floor marking tapes).

NOTE

Self-adhesive tapes are used in many different applications and are therefore designed and manufactured taking their intended end use into account.

Due to the nature of the product itself, a self-adhesive tape may be used for applications that are completely different from those for which it was designed.

Anyone intending to use self-adhesive tapes for purposes other than those intended by the manufacturer must carry out specific technical tests to ensure that the product is suitable for that use and must comply with the technical and legal requirements governing the final intended use.

In essence, if self-adhesive tapes are used for purposes not intended by the manufacturer, the user - whether professional or private - assumes responsibility for any resulting consequences and/or regulatory non-compliance.
